Footnotes

KENS CAPE broke inward and was brushed, moved to command soon after, edged clear nearing the turn, set a rapid pace under rating, was guided out off the inside in upper stretch, met the challenge of MANITO leaving the eighth pole, dueled under left handed pressure, briefly lost command near the sixteenth marker then battled back gamely to get the narrow decision. MANITO, taken to rate early while three wide, quickly reached a striking position mid turn, moved to collar the winner soon past the furlong grounds, dueled on the slimmest of leads inside the sixteenth marker but just could not hold the final strides. FRONTIER WARRIOR was checked when in tight a stride out of the gate, moved up three wide between rivals mid turn while under strong urging, chased the top pair in upper stretch, shifted in late and finished with interest. DELAUNAY settled back four wide, was put to a five wide drive in upper stretch, gained ground nearing the eighth pole, continued to close the gap but was outfinished. DADDYROE saved ground off the early pace, was under a ride mid turn, got through inside leaving the furlong marker, angled out and had some belated action. TOO WILD FOR WORDS chased the pace while off the rail and faded. JACK ON THE ROCKS bobbed at the break then had his rider briefly lose his irons when jostled a couple strides out, regrouped to stalk the pace, eased back some nearing the turn, raced two wide into the stretch and gave way.
