Footnotes

LISETTE , taken to rate well off the rail and off of a contested pace, advanced five wide nearing the lane, responded to stout left handed pressure and forged to command nearing mid stretch, had her rider switch the to right hand inside the furlong pole and edged away through the final sixteenth. CALOCAGATHIA disputed the pace three to four wide racing between rivals, edged clear in upper stretch, was collared past the three sixteenths pole and stayed on gamely to be well clear for the place. SIMPLE SONGS attended the pace four to five wide, continued forwardly to the quarter pole but faded when called upon for her best. EMOSEWA was rated back from between rivals near the five eighths pole, chased the leaders around the turn then tired before going six furlongs. EAT CAKE , urged along soon after the break, failed to respond. RUSHLYNs TRIBUTE set a pressured pace three wide inside rivals, was overtaken after a half mile and faltered.
