PRINCESS FRANNY set a pressured pace off the inside, turned back BREADKNIFE in mid stretch and proved best under a stiff right handed drive. BREADKNIFE wore a nasal strip, prompted the winner three wide, drew even nearing mid stretch, drifted out and hung. BACKROOM BLUES raced between rivals on the turn, angled to the inside in upper stretch and closed willingly. DISTANT LIGHT stalked the pace four wide and faded. FIFTH AVENUE FLIRT wore a nasal strip, raced in mid pack off the rail and failed to respond. MISS BROAD broke slowly and lacked speed, raced six wide into the lane and needed more. ONE MORE FLAG saved ground and was not a factor. ROYAL RIFF saved ground in a forward position, steadied mid way on the turn and dropped back. ROYAL CONE was taken up at the start, raced three wide into the lane and failed to menace.
