Footnotes

CAME EAST , bumped at the break, was taken to rate while three wide early, advanced four to five wide into the stretch, closed sharply under left handed pressure leaving the eighth pole, took command with about seventy yards remaining then eagerly drew away. S K R'S SPARTAN prompted the pace three wide, quickly moved to command leaving the three eighths pole, kicked away approaching the stretch, remained well clear past the eighth pole, continued willingly but was no match for the winner. FEARLESS COWBOY was steadied nearing the turn, came three wide for the drive and had a mild response while gaining the show. LEGAL CODE was angled in entering the turn, chased the pace around the turn, made a mild move in upper stretch then faded in the final furlong. LATE NIGHT LOVER bumped with the winner leaving the gate, was taken to the rail soon after while off the pace, swung four wide in upper stretch then came up empty. RAINBOW INTHESTORM sprinted clear early, set the pace two wide, was overtaken leaving the three eighths pole, gave little fight and faltered entering the lane.
