TO THE CROWD stalked the pace two wide, moved to command entering the lane, opened up a clear lead in mid stretch and held safe under a drive. SERAI , forwardly placed, advanced three wide into the stretch and finished willingly. MS. BANKER settled early, saved ground while advancing mid turn, eased out in upper stretch and finished with interest. SEVENTEEN ABOVE , taken to rate, saved ground into the lane and offered a belated response. FROST LADY , in mid pack under urging, came four wide for the drive, made a mild run nearing mid stretch, drifted out late and faded. TRUE FASHION failed to keep pace. PSYCO GATOR was outrun. ROBIN DES TUNE sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside for a half mile then tired in upper stretch.
