### Footnotes

FONDANT sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and prevailed under urging. LADDER TO THE MOON, swung wide in upper stretch, impeded PROFIT when drifting in approaching the eighth pole and rallied. LOVE IN PARIS, lightly steadied in traffic entering the turn, saved ground, eased out near the eighth pole and failed to sustain her bid. PROFIT chased the pace outside the winner, gave way in upper stretch and was checked when shut off by LOVE IN PARIS approaching the eighth pole. DESIDERATA, wide entering the stretch, gave way. DERRYWALL, very wide entering the stretch, refused to switch to her right lead and faltered. Following a stewards' inquiry, LOVE IN PARIS was disqualified and placed fourth.
