COP A TUDE , bumped at the break, was up close up early while rated, dropped back a bit under some urging into the turn, regrouped to edge closer mid turn, swung out four wide entering the lane, split rivals leaving the eighth pole, kicked clear then held firm under a drive. ROCKY GAP was steadied off heels while wide near the three and a half furlong marker, raced in range past the five sixteenths marker, angled five wide for the drive, moved with the winner nearing mid stretch, continued gamely but was second best. TIN STAR tracked the pace three wide, made a quick bit to take over in upper stretch, forged clear past the three sixteenths marker, was collared inside the eighth pole and faded. SPANISH OFFICER stalked the pace two wide, moved between rivals to challenge in upper stretch then weakened leaving the eighth pole. RASS STONE broke outward bumping with the winner, rushed up inside soon after and went clear with five furlongs remaining, set the pace into the lane then faltered leaving the three sixteenths pole.
