GIANT TRUST chased the pace outside DERWIN'S SHAMROCK, took command in upper stretch then pulled away under urging. MARINE HYMN , two wide on the turn, angled outside DERWIN'S SHAMROCK in midstretch and rallied. IRUNALATTE circled the turn three wide and rallied mildly. DERWIN'S SHAMROCK sped to a clear, early lead, set the pace along the rail, drifted out a bit in midstretch then tired. MAY KING , in the three path around the turn, was never a factor. MALIBU MADNESS was outrun. LITTLE GRANDPA broke slowly and inward, lacked speed while saving ground, eased outside in midstretch and showed mild, late interest. GULF COAST , along the rail on the turn, chased the pace to the stretch then faltered. BET THE CAT trailed after breaking slowly.
