WALLOP broke a bit sluggishly, raced three wide on the turn, closed and was along in time under vigorous rousing. STORM HEN dueled along the rail, opened up in midstretch then weakened. SINKING FEELING raced in the three path in the stretch and rallied between horses. JEANIE'S GOLD, swung wide at the head of the stretch, failed to sustain her bid. SHEAPEALSTOME disputed the pace outside STORM HEN and gave way in midstretch. PFILERUP, swung wide entering the stretch, lacked a rally. ROBIN DES TUNE chased the pace three wide and gave way. CLEVER MANEUVER was outrun. BRIEF AFFAIR was outrun after stumbling at the break.
