Footnotes

MALIBU MOONSHINE lacked room along the rail entering the turn, swung very wide in upper stretch, took command in midstretch and drew clear under steady handling. LEGAL CONTROL , rated early, raced very wide around the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch and gave way when challenged. SEIZE raced between horses on the turn, swung wide for the drive, raced on his left lead and rallied mildly. SUENO DEL MAR , a forward factor two wide, weakened. HOIST AWAY , in tight quarters between horses near the three and a half furlongs pole, weakened. WOODY'S APACHE , no factor, raced very wide. MR. CLIVEDEN had speed along the rail and weakened. FAMILY GHOST pressed the pace two wide and gave way. HE'S LOOKIN GOOD , checked in traffic entering the turn, was soundly bumped by GOLD JOY near the three sixteenths pole. HE DEVIL raced wide and gave way. GOLD JOY , bumped and checked in tight quarters entering the turn, gave way, bore out and bumped HE'S LOOKIN GOOD in upper stretch.
