Footnotes

TWO DRAGONS , forwardly placed five wide chasing the early pace, eased back a bit mid turn, swung out and circled seven wide into the stretch, closed steadily under right handed pressure, collared SENOR FUEGO near the sixteenth marker then drew clear. SENOR FUEGO set the early pace in the four path, was joined past the five eighths pole, dueled briefly, pressed NIGHT Q around the turn, came back in the five path to challenge near mid stretch, gained command soon after, was confronted by the winner a sixteenth out, gave way grudgingly but was well clear for the place. NIGHT Q moved up in the three path inside SENOR FUEGO after a quarter mile, dueled, moved clear after a half mile, edged away a bit while continuing off the inside into the lane, was joined nearing the furlong marker and weakened a sixteenth out. HEAVENSTMURGATROID was angled in early and taken to rate, lagged well back around the turn, swung eight wide in upper stretch but lacked a solid response. PENDULUM stalked the pace five wide, made a mild move mid turn, chased the leader into the lane and weakened. COURTING WISDOM , between rivals early chasing the pace, angled to the rail around the turn and faltered before going a half mile.
