PERFECT SCORE, rated just off the pace, eased out three wide entering the stretch, finished determinedly and narrowly prevailed. MR. KATOWICE disputed the pace racing in the two path and finished gamely. RAIRE STANDARD, bumped and pinched back leaving the starting gate, angled out in upper stretch and rallied. WELL INTENDED saved ground and failed to menace. MORE BETTER, two wide between rivals, weakened. HUSH ITSAS SECRET set the pace along the rail and gave way. SMART GUY circled the turn in an even trip. DR. FALLON circled and fell back.
