DANCE TO BRISTOL relaxed three wide just off of a contested pace, moved in hand to engage mid turn, took over in upper stretch, spurted away soon after, was roused once right handed inside the eighth pole then increased her advantage under minimal encouragement. FEAR THE FACELIFT settled off the early pace, was put to a drive leaving the three eighths pole, angled out gathering momentum soon after, made a four wide run at the winner inside the three sixteenths marker, kept on willingly but was no match. ISLAND BOUND, in close soon after the break, came under pressure mid turn, circled five wide into the lane and closed willingly. NORTH FREEWAY dueled early along the rail, took continued pressure past the five sixteenths marker, relinquished command in upper stretch then tired in the final furlong. DEFY GRAVITY disputed the pace outside NORTH FREEWAY and gave way in upper stretch.
