Footnotes

LASER LAD, taken to rate two wide, moved closer mid turn, swung out four wide for the drive surged to command leaving the eighth pole and eagerly drew off under a drive. MR NOTEBOOK lagged early, swung out six wide leaving the furlong marker, found his best late and just got up for the place. TASTING CHAMPAGNE took a brief early lead, prompted the pace two wide into and around the turn, continued willingly to the wire and just missed second. CREVE COEUR advanced inside nearing the five furlong marker to take a short lead, moved clear around the far turn, was headed approaching the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly. JENKIN JONES lacked speed, saved ground into and through the lane but failed to mount a solid rally. SHORT HAIR stalked the pace three wide and faded. SKYCROSSING saved ground, was urged along nearing the three eighths pole, angled out entering the lane and faded.
