QUEEN CONCERTO moved inside of CHARLIE SUNSHINE to take command mid way on the first turn, was nicely handled while taking pressure from that rival, was guided out three to four wide entering the stretch, dueled on near even terms when straightened away a furlong out, responded to strong handling and kicked clear in the final sixteenth. CHARLI SUNSHINE prompted the pace three wide, came under pressure mid way on the turn, re-bid outside the winner in upper stretch, dueled past the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly in a nice effort. MERRYLAND MOON was lightly steadied off heels when appearing to want to get out entering the first turn, stalked the pace while in the clear, came wide for the drive and failed to generate the needed kick. MALIBU MURMUR settled in mid pack, circled four wide into the stretch but had no significant rally. VASILEA, in a bit close at the break, saved ground off the pace, made a decent run in upper stretch then flattened out. PLUM lagged back, raced wide the far turn and failed to menace.
