SUPER QUIET settled three to four wide while within range, advanced four wide under a ride to gain on the dueling leaders in upper stretch, sustained her run under right handed pressure, moved ahead of MISS PAVAROTTI a sixteenth out, dueled and edged clear at the wire. MISS PAVAROTTI rated kindly three wide just off the pace, moved to engage TORCHME after six furlongs, dueled outside that rival past the furlong pole, was confronted by the winner soon after, dueled inside that one to about fifty yards out then gave way grudgingly. PROUD PEARL, reluctant to load when fractious behind the starting gate, lagged back while off the inside, came under pressure around the final turn, raced four wide in upper stretch and had a belated response. TORCHME rushed up from the outside and dropped in sharply when going clear one mile out, set a rated pace, took pressure from the three eighths pole, dueled inside MISS PAVAROTTI from the five sixteenths marker past the eighth pole then gave way in the final seventy yards. FOURSOUTHERNBELLES, bumped at the break, was rated off the rail and not too far off the pace, made some progress near the quarter pole then lacked a strong kick in the final furlong. WILL N' PAT settled back along the rail, made slight progress when asked nearing the far turn, swung out for the drive but failed to threaten. MALIBU CREEK broke outward and bumped with FOURSOUTHERNBELLES, angled outward early stalked two wide, made a mild bid under urging three furlongs out and tired.
