NATURE CHANT stalked the pace three wide, closed inside ISLANDER BLUES and drew off. ISLANDER BLUES was unhurried early, raced wide around the turn, gained a clear lead in midstretch and was no match for the winner. BOW BOW raced inside horses into the stretch and shut off BANNER KEY when bearing out in midstretch. MI MI MINE lacked speed, raced in the four path through the stretch, was brushed by BANNER KEY in midstretch and finished willingly. NUMERATOR stalked the pace and raced very wide into the stretch. BANNER KEY raced in the three path between horses and was steadied and forced out when shut off by BOW BOW. PLENTY O' WOMAN set the pace near the rail and weakened. SIRENUSE raced wide and was no factor. PULVERIZINGASSAULT raced along the rail and gave way. MISS MARY CASE chased the pace two wide and stopped the final furlong. Following a stewards' inquiry, BOW BOW was disqualified and placed sixth. .
