MARSHALL lacked speed, was three deep on the far turn, angled to the inner rail in upper stretch, closed inside horses and was up in time. ZAGARELLO set the pace in the two path, drifted out in upper stretch and finished gamely. PUNTA SAL saved ground stalking the pace, gained a short lead inside ZAGARELLO in upper stretch, drifted out approaching the eighth pole and weakened. ALL BORN SINNERS lacked speed, lost ground racing five wide around the far turn and flattened out in the drive. EVENING CONCERTO advanced four wide to reach contention on the far turn, remained prominent to midstretch then weakened late. WHATDOYOUSEE , in the two path entering the far turn, faltered. OUR BAILIWICK , three wide both turns, prompted the pace and faltered in upper stretch.
