APRIL'S FOIL dueled two wide, drifted three wide entering the lane, forged well clear past the furlong marker, responded to solid handling and held sway. STAND UP STAN stumbled inward at the break, recovered and rushed up between rivals, tracked the dueling leaders three wide, came a bit wider for the drive and finished willingly to close the gap. ROSEMONT DRIVE dueled inside to upper stretch and faded late. BARRY MEATBALL, fractious in the gate, chased wide and had a mild late response. MAZZARD, four to five wide, lacked a solid run. SWIM FOR GIN failed to menace. COUNT FLOYD bobbled at the break, was bit a rank early, saved ground but failed to generate the needed closing kick. TIGGER TOO, urged along saving ground mid turn, eased out for the drive and came up empty. FULLMOONATBUMBAS, hustled along giving chase off the rail, dropped back.
