Footnotes

HAM AND ERNIE settled back early, advanced between rivals while under a ride mid way on the final turn, came four wide for the drive, blew past the dueling leaders approaching the eighth pole and drew off under a drive. GIMMEASCOTCH , three wide into the first turn, stalked the pace two wide, moved to challenge leaving the three eighths pole, dueled between rivals in upper stretch then gave way grudgingly. TYRAE was used four wide entering the backstretch, advanced three wide into the far turn, lodged a three wide bid around the final turn, dueled in upper stretch then was outfinished for the place. THE JUICE IS LOOSE cleared early, set the pace inside, was collared after six furlongs, dueled to upper stretch then faded in the final seventy yards. TWO OURS saved ground, gained some ground leaving the far turn, angled out for the drive and gave way. HERE COMES MIKEY broke slowly and had a wide trip. MANE MACHO chased the early pace off the rail, dropped back and was angled five wide around the final turn. P. VEE'S THUNDER broke slowly and was outrun. RUMBLEY was pulled up in early backstretch and walked off.
