PASSEGGIATA (ARG), in hand four wide, moved closer into the stretch, drew even in deep stretch, dueled with CATINCA and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. CATINCA bobbed start, prompted the pace three wide, gained command in upper stretch, dueled late and just failed in a sharp effort. NOTHING SPECIAL, close up between rivals, angled to the rail in deep stretch and was outfinished. PALETTE KNIFE was hustled along the rail, eased out in the drive and needed more. CHEERS AND TEARS prompted the pace three wide between rivals and lacked a stretch response. TUZIA outrun early inside, angled out for the drive and failed to respond. ARCILLA lacked speed and raced widest in the stretch. BIDING TIME set a pressured pace slightly off the rail, held a slim lead into the lane and gave way leaving the eighth pole.
