RICHARD'S KID lacked speed, circled horses on the far turn, swung to the five path entering the stretch, closed determinedly and drove clear late. BULLSBAY saved ground, eased out two wide near the five sixteenths pole, overtook P V LIGHTENING in upper stretch, led to deep stretch and weakened late. P V LIGHTENING saved ground disputing the pace, opened up on the far turn and faded in the drive. QUIP (ARG) stalked the pace well off the rail and failed to rally. SHARPS ISLAND, four wide entering the first turn, saved ground around the far turn, advanced along the rail to midstretch then weakened. ADMIRAL'S CRUISE hesitated at the break, raced three wide on the far turn and tired in upper stretch. INDEPENDENT BANKER, brushed by RYAN'S FOR REAL soon after the break, gave way. RYAN'S FOR REAL came out and brushed INDEPENDENT BANKER after stumbling at the break then failed to be a factor. SOUTHERN RAINBOW dueled outside P V LIGHTENING and faltered entering the stretch.
