### Footnotes

STONE GROOVE , three wide in the stretch, split horses in midstretch and narrowly prevailed. SAINTTWOK , unhurried early, swung very wide entering the stretch, led late and hung. RICO ENDS WELL broke a bit slowly, drifted wide in upper stretch and weakened. SUNSHINE IN PARIS raced along the rail on the turn, eased out in upper stretch and finished willingly. CARA'S LASSIE raced wide and failed to rally. SHOWMETHEGREENCARD circled the turn, led in upper stretch and gave way. AYRES HALL had speed along the rail, weakened and was being eased late. CARNIE'S SECRET pressed the pace two wide and gave way. .
