SCOTCHONTHEROCKS sprinted clear early, set a rapid pace along the rail, opened up under strong encouragement nearing the furlong marker then held a safe margin while kept alert to the final yards. A BIT OF MADNESS rushed to contention, chased the winner while off the rail, came three to four wide for the drive and stayed gamely to save the place. BENNY THE WAITER was nudged along in a stalking position towards the inside, angled out mid turn, came four to five wide for the drive, made some progress in the final eighth but was outfinished for the place. LOUANN'S BOOT , hustled along towards the inside leaving the three eighths pole, made a mild two wide gain in upper stretch then flattened out. IRISH BLAST , four wide into the lane, had some belated action. GLENWOOD ACE broke slowly, was taken to rate around the turn, came three wide for the drive, altered out some near mid stretch then had some belated interest. MY BULLET , wide, was not a factor. ROCK N' BID failed to respond.
