WELL FANCIED broke on top, set a rated pace in the two path, took pressure from BADGE OF SILVER entering the lane, edged away from that one leaving the eighth pole and held sway under a drive. UNFORGETTABLE MAX , unhurried early while off the rail, angled out early turn, advanced five wide entering the lane and finished gamely. GATORS N BEARS , forwardly placed towards the inside, continued willingly and saved the show. PEEPING TOM , outrun early while saving ground, moved closer leaving the three furlong marker, swung out six wide for the drive and closed gamely. BADGE OF SILVER prompted the pace three wide, tried the winner entering the lane, battled to mid stretch then faded. WAY TO THE TOP saved ground throughout and came up empty. MY GOOD TRICK angled out entering the turn, steadily advanced four wide mid turn, raced between rivals in mid stretch but had no late response. OUT OF FASHION raced prominently between rivals to the head of the lane then gradually weakened in the drive. FOUNDING CHAIRMAN , fractious in the gate, raced three wide in a forward position to the turn, dropped back on the turn and could not recover.
