FUNNYS APPROVAL advanced inside of CELTIC CHANT to take command nearing the five eighths pole, was nicely rated setting the pace off the rail, edged clear into the turn, remained under patient handling when challenged from both sides near the quarter pole, responded when sharply roused right handed inside the three sixteenths marker and held firm. MY WANDY'S GIRL stalked under rating while saving ground, quickly gained along the rail mid turn, bid inside the winner with a quarter remaining, kept on gamely to the wire but was held at bay. WITHGREATPLEASURE was shuffled back soon after the break, moved to the rail, angled out commencing her run mid turn, circled very wide into the stretch and closed willingly. NICOLE H , fractious in the gate, settled off the pace while removed from the rail, was coaxed along between runners exiting the far turn, shifted out for the drive but failed to generate a significant response. MS. CRUISEN' settled off the rail three wide, made a slight gain mid turn, swung well wide in upper stretch and came up empty. MORROW COVE lacked speed, came under pressure three wide around the turn but could not threaten. ONEPOINTHREEKARATS settled in the clear while about four wide, range up to threaten leaving mid turn, pressed briefly into the stretch the faltered with three sixteenths remaining. CELTIC CHANT , away alertly, prompted the winner three wide and faltered before going five furlongs.
