JOE VANN set the pace in the two path, drifted to the rail in upper stretch while opening up and prevailed while kept to his business. HUGHES NEXT saved ground, chased the pace and rallied. SMALL TOWN TALK circled the turn, had aim on the leader in upper stretch then weakened in the drive. WARRENSBURG saved ground on the turn and passed tired horses late. SAMPO came in soon after the break, raced inside horses on the turn, swung out entering the stretch and failed to rally. MYSTICAL TERP , bumped soon after the break, was checked in tight quarters along the rail near the five and a half furlongs pole, swung wide entering the stretch and was outrun. BALTO MORE , between horses on the turn, chased the pace to the stretch then faltered in upper stretch. FLYING POWER was outrun. COUNT TO SEVEN , outrun, was fanned wide near the quarter pole.
