Footnotes

IDLE HOUR rated forwardly while saving ground, got through along the rail when advancing into the stretch, shifted out in upper stretch, closed determinedly under right handed pressure and got up in the final strides. BETRAYED set a rated pace inside, edged away in upper stretch, responded to strong left handed pressure, battled gamely once collared in deep stretch and just missed. SKIP THE NIGHT had a three wide trip stalking the pace, came under strong pressure leaving the five sixteenths marker, failed to respond and faded through the drive. RUN FOR SHELTER, off the rail while well within range, was urged along leaving the far turn, came four wide for the drive and faded. BLAZING HONOR, wide, was not a factor. KAIN'S CITY hesitated at the break, was angled in and taken to rate, came under pressure around the final turn, continued inside for the stretch run but could not factor. CAKE WALK prompted the pace two wide, was asked for her best mid way on the final turn, failed to kick in and tired through the final three sixteenths.
