Preference will be given to Breeders' Cup nominees only of equal racing quality or high weight assignment (respective of sex and weight for age). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the winning owner given by the Breeders' Cup Ltd. Closed Wednesday February 6, 2008 with 27 nominations.

BUSTIN STONES set a pressured pace along the rail while under some rating, shook clear in upper stretch, responded to left handed pressure inside the sixteenth marker and narrowly prevailed. LORD SNOWDON broke a step slow, saved ground while outrun early, angled out leaving mid turn, came four wide for the drive, exchanged bumps with PREMIUM WINE leaving the eighth pole, closed gamely and just missed. PREMIUM WINE, taken to rate inside, moved closer entering the lane, waited briefly in upper stretch, shifted out, was bumped and tight when trying to get through a seam past the eighth pole then finished up gamely. RYAN'S FOR REAL stalked the pace two wide, angled three wide mid turn, made a mild run entering the stretch, was brushed leaving the eighth pole then flattened out. THRONG stalked the pace while saving ground, continued a solid presence to mid stretch then faded. STORMIN NORMANDY prompted the pace outside the winner, was in a bit tight near the furlong marker and gave way. DIVINE PARK broke through the gate pre race, was urged along three wide into the turn, had no response and dropped back.
