VIA AURELIA lacked speed, raced wide leaving the turn, drifted in a bit near the three sixteenths pole, closed and drove clear. BETTERBEMONTBROOK bore out leaving the starting gate, chased the pace two wide and finished willingly. VALUEADDEDPARTNER, quickly clear, set the pace in the two path and weakened late. VESTED IN TOWN hugged the rail, steadied near the half mile pole, was rank entering the turn, steadied behind horses near the eighth pole then rallied mildly inside. ALLEGHENY MOON saved ground, chased the pace and gave way. FANTASTIC REVIEW broke slowly, swung wide in upper stretch and showed a mild, late response. PURPLISH, very wide leaving the turn, failed to rally. NASEEB bore in leaving the starting gate, chased the pace three wide around the turn and faltered after her rider dropped his whip inside the three sixteenths pole.
