MAGICAL FEELING settled back off the pace while saving ground, angled out four wide when gathering momentum nearing the lane, drifted out from left handed pressure leaving the eighth pole, was straightened with strong right handed encouragement, surged between rivals and got up in the final jumps. NICOLE H prompted a slow early pace three wide under rating, cruised to a clear lead after a half mile, dropped in towards the rail when widening in upper stretch, was called on left handed a furlong out but failed to hold on. C C'S PAL bobbled at the break but quickly recovered to reach a perfect tracking position off of a three pronged duel, angled four wide and edged closer entering the lane, drifted out when her rider switched to left handed pressure the final yards, closed the gap but just wasn't quite good enough. AQUITANIA, quickly to contention, dueled inside rivals for nearly a half mile, chased the leader into the stretch then gradually gave way. SILVER HEART dropped back to last after a half mile, raced wide for the drive, had some belated interest but failed to threaten. LOVELY LIL gained a short lead while dueling between rivals, relinquished command into the turn, chased NICOLE H around the turn and into the lane then faded. RED'S ROUND TABLE stumbled to her nose at the break losing all chance then saved ground throughout the rest of her trip.
