Footnotes

DO IT FOR DON stumbled after being soundly bumped by SAVINGS N LOAN soon after the break, moved up in the four path entering the turn, closed outside horses, took the lead approaching the eighth pole and drew clear. LIGHT OF MY LIFE hugged the rail around the turn, angled to the two path in midstretch and rallied. PHOTOGENIC slammed into SAVINGS N LOAN, when bearing in leaving the starting gate, left the turn in the five path, drifted in near the three sixteenths pole and rallied. CITIZEN CHRIS accelerated to a long, early lead, set the pace along the rail and faltered in the drive. SAVINGS N LOAN, forced into DOT IT FOR DON when soundly bumped by PHOTOGENIC leaving the starting gate, was a three wide factor on the turn, was in range in upper stretch then weakened late. LE TRICHEUR was outrun after bobbling at the break. KABUTO was a brief, two wide factor then weakened on the turn. SAFE NET, forced in soon after the break, was outrun. Following a stewards' inquiry and an objection by the rider of SAVINGS N LOAN, PHOTOGENIC was disqualified and placed fifth.
