INDIAN BUCKS prompted the pace under some nudging, asserted himself and overtook IMPERIAL BLUEGRAZZ as the field straightened for the wire, kicked clear under left handed pressure leaving the three sixteenths marker, drifted in a bit and held firm. IT'S MY PEROGATIVE stalked the pace while saving ground, came under pressure mid turn, swung out four wide into the lane, loomed boldly but could not match strides in a willing effort. GREEN CANYON , four wide chasing the pace, made slight run in mid stretch then flattened out. BROAD MOON stalked the pace off the rail, raced between foes nearing the eighth pole and lacked the needed kick. PERILOUS INDIAN saved ground under urging around the turn, lacked a bid. GEORGETOWN BURNING , five wide into the turn, failed to menace. IMPERIAL BLUEGRAZZ moved clear early and angled in to the two path, was joined from the outside by the winner after a quarter mile, was pushed along setting a pressured pace, relinquished command into the lane and tired through the final three sixteenths. BUCK TRADITION broke inward, was outrun. FILM STAR dropped far back.
