Footnotes

TAP TO MUSIC lacked speed, circled horses leaving the backstretch, raced three wide between foes on the turn, dueled outside HER SHE KISSES through the stretch and prevailed under a drive. HER SHE KISSES saved ground disputing the pace in a sharp effort. DI'S TIME bore in at the start, raced in the two path on the turn and rallied. LADY TAP , pinched back at the start, raced very wide into the stretch and rallied. RED'S LADY raced in the two path and passed faders. PASSEGGIATA (ARG) raced very wide and failed to sustain her bid. SMART LADYS FRIEND dueled two wide, gave way and drifted out in midstretch. SHASHOBEGON lacked a rally along the rail. APPEALING PHYLly raced wide. GOLD FROM THE WEST was outrun. SPEEDING STAR (ARG) was no factor after being pinched back leaving the starting gate. POTOMAC BEND gave way. RILLS raced wide and dropped back.
