PEEPING TOM settled along the inside, moved up in hand approaching the quarter pole, swung five wide into the lane, closed sharply, gained command near the sixteenth pole and drew clear under a drive. DELAWARE TOWNSHIP stalked the pace three wide, was set down three furlongs out, made a four wide run at the top into the lane, finished willingly and was clearly second best. DISCO RICO dueled two wide in hand through brisk fractions, was set down in upper stretch, held a slim lead past the furlong marker then faded. P DAY raced wide and lacked a solid response. LOVE ALL THE WAY raced between rivals early, saved ground into the lane and came up empty. TROUNCE was well placed off of a contested pace, advanced between rivals near the quarter pole but couldn't match strides in the lane. LEXICON dueled inside with DISCO RICO, tired in upper stretch and drifted out.
