Footnotes

UNREPENTANT , forwardly placed three wide to the head of the lane, angled out four wide for the drive, closed steadily under strong handling, took command late and drew clear. GULF OF GDANSK cleared early, set a slow rated pace, entered the lane two wide, was set down in mid stretch, switched leads inside the sixteenth marker and gave way grudgingly. GRAN AMIGA (ARG) stalked the pace off the rail and gained the show in the final jumps. NICELITTLEPACKAGE saved ground, was lightly steadied on the turn, continued inside through the lane and lacked a solid response. CARNI DAS rated close up along the rail in the early going, angled out to stalk the winner on the turn then went evenly in the drive. SASS N' CLASS , lightly steadied at the break, faltered and was not abused.
