COAST LINE quickly assumed command, set the pace under some rating along the inside, was joined by OFFLEE WILD entering the lane, dueled from the three sixteenths marker to deep stretch and proved best under strong handling. OFFLEE WILD , away alertly, prompted the winner two wide, moved to even terms entering the lane, dueled and just missed in a game return. OLE FAUNTY , well placed throughout, lacked a late response. OUAGADOUGOU broke a step slow, was unhurried early, saved ground into the lane, made a mild run in mid stretch then flattened out. JIM THIRDS BOLERO was taken to rate towards the inside in early backstretch then came up empty when called upon. YOUR BLUFFING , well placed early, was urged along off the rail into the far turn and steadily retreated. LITTLE MATTH MAN broke a step slow, was used wide into the far turn and faltered.
