ART OF THE HUNT stalked the pace three wide, moved between rivals to challenge entering the lane, responded to rousing and took command inside the quarter pole then steadily drew away while kept to solid pressure. SOME moved up inside nearing the five eighths pole to gain a forward position, eased out into the lane, shifted out wider past the furlong marker and finished with decent energy to get up for the place. PRINCESS DAISY tracked the pace four wide, steadily advanced to gain a short lead after six furlongs, dueled briefly outside the winner, drifted in late, faded and lost the place. THE STORMY C prompted the early pace outside L'ANCH, chased that one past three eighths pole, dropped back four wide into the stretch and failed to muster up a late response. L'ANCH moved up inside rivals leaving the chute to take command, took some early pressure, edged clear after a half mile, moved away some mid turn, was collared entering the stretch and tired nearing the furlong marker. OVER AND ABOVE, off the rail, was outrun. MOON VALLEY lacked speed, raced wide and failed to menace. PRIVATE TAP, off slowly, saved ground and faltered.
