HARISSA, patiently rated in the three path down the backstretch, angled out near the turn, made a bold four wide run into the lane, responded to solid left handed pressure when collaring ASPENGLow in upper stretch, dueled past the furlong grounds, had her rider switch to the right hand when assuming command a sixteenth out then edged away late under an energetic ride. ASPENGLow advanced inside rivals leaving the chute and gained a clear advantage, set a solid pace three wide under rating, was joined by the winner in upper stretch, dueled on a short lead past the eighth pole, was overtaken a sixteenth out then gave way grudgingly. FASCINATIN' RHYTHM, sluggish from the gate, settled well off the rail down the backstretch, circled five wide into the stretch and finished up with interest to best the rest. MEESE ROCKS stalked the pace, moved towards the inside around the turn, failed to respond when asked for her best nearing the lane and gradually gave way in the final furlong. SWEET GOODBYE tracked the pace four wide, was ridden along past the three eighths pole, failed to keep pace and gave way in the drive. R BETTY GRAYBULL was rated back between rivals soon after the break, angled to the inside while well off the pace and never offered a run. KID KATE lacked speed off the rail, was angled five wide in upper stretch but could not threaten.
