TALK ME INTO IT sprinted up leaving the backstretch to gain a two wide lead entering the turn, drifted wide entering the stretch, eagerly pulled away and was under brisk urging through the stretch. BEYOND MIDNIGHT showed speed along the rail, failed to keep pace with the winner, drifted out entering the stretch, weakened and held the place. POLONEZ raced in the two path between horses on the turn, angled to the three path in upper stretch and passed tired foes. SHE REALLY DIGS ME circled the turn three deep, floated to the four path turning for home and was not a factor. PURE DREAMS showed brief speed, raced along the rail and dropped back on the turn. ICELANDIC BLAST raced slightly off the rail on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. MORE PUNCH saved ground on the turn and gave way in upper stretch.
