Footnotes

FASHION ISLAND was taken back off of MANY THREES around the first turn, stalked that one under a rating hold, moved two wide to command mid way on the final turn, kicked well clear in upper stretch and held sway under a strong hand ride. YARRAY was unhurried early while saving ground, moved up between rivals in upper stretch, drifted out while under some left handed pressure and gamely earned the place. TULEYRIES was allowed to settle while off the rail, picked up momentum four wide approaching the stretch, made a run approaching the furlong marker then was herded out some by YARRAY in the final sixteenth of a mile. MAGIC THURSDAY, three wide chasing the pace, was put to strong urging around the final turn and faded. MONOCLE was allowed to settle, moved up some leaving the three furlong marker, steadied when lacking room approaching the stretch, swung out six wide but failed to threaten. BLUFFIE SLEW raced in mid pack, was hustled along around the final turn and weakened. MANY THREES sprinted clear early, set the pace along the inside, was overtaken after six furlongs, battled to the head of the lane then tired. STEPIT broke a step slow, was checked on the heels of rivals entering the first turn, lost ground four wide down the backstretch, made a mild run into the far turn, tired then was carried out some entering the lane. A claim of foul by the rider of TULEYRIES against YARRAY for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed.
