AFFIRMED SUCCESS stalked the leaders, raced four wide around the turn, opened a clear lead in upper stretch and dug in late to prevail. YOUNG AT HEART raced very wide entering the stretch, lugged in near the eighth pole and closed gamely outside the winner. BADGE rated behind horses, raced four wide into the stretch, angled in near the eighth pole and closed between the top pair. BLACK CASH raced five wide around the turn and lacked a rally. NAWMON lacked speed, raced very wide and passed tired horses. PERFECT SCORE raced between horses and weakened in the drive. IRON PUNCH had speed along the rail and weakened. CAT BE NIMBLE had speed three wide between horses and gave way. WISE DUSTY dueled two wide between rivals and dropped back. .
