VIVA BLANDA broke outward, was unhurried in the trail spot early, picked up momentum along the inside on the final turn, swung five wide entering the lane, closed strongly under right handed urging and got up in the final strides. COMPELLING MOON set the pace along the inside, dueled from the three furlong to mid stretch, came back to take command nearing the sixteenth pole, held well but got nailed in the final strides. NOT A PROBLEM stalked the pace three wide, lodged a bid leaving the far turn, dueled, took a short lead nearing mid stretch, had her rider lose his whip soon after, battled to the sixteenth marker then faded. SELENA ROSE stalked the pace two wide, was pushed along nearing the far turn but failed to respond. MADAMNE Q saved ground early, finished with interest but failed to threaten. PARLEZ, three wide the first turn, lost ground five wide around the final turn and failed to generate a solid response. HERE COMES ROOTIE angled in early, stalked the dueling leaders around the final turn, swung out approaching the quarter pole and tired. TELEGRAPH ROAD lost ground four wide and dropped back.
