H. R. H. DOODLE broke sharply, prompted the dueling leaders three wide, lodged a bid approaching the quarter pole, came in some and exchanged brushes with HARD GAL B, dueled from the furlong marker and got the nose bob at the wire. HARD GAL B broke sharply, dueled along the inside, brushed wit the winner in the lane, regained a slim lead inside the sixteenth pole, battled gamely but was nailed on the wire. GABIANNA rated close up behind the dueling leaders, angled out four wide entering the lane and finished willingly. SALISBURY SLEW saved ground and finished with interest in a useful effort. LIGHT REFLECTIONS raced off the rail and came up empty. LITTLE TARA rushed up outside of HARD GAL B in the opening furlong, dueled two wide, took a brief lead between rivals nearing the lane then faltered leaving the three sixteenths marker. An objection by the rider of HARD GAL B against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed.
