### Footnotes

THUNDER CHARM settled back early along the rail, advanced leaving the far turn, angled out under a ride mid turn, rallied four wide to command nearing the sixteenth marker and drew clear under pressure. QUANTICO HERO cleared early, set the pace inside, took pressure from the five sixteenths marker to upper stretch, shook back clear leaving the three sixteenths pole, gave way grudgingly and was well clear of the rest. TAKE DOWN TWO, three wide into the first turn, stalked the pace two wide, moved to threaten leaving the three eighths pole, forced the pace into the lane then faded in the final furlong. A BEE C chased the pace off the rail and failed to respond. COURT BAND lost ground three to four wide and was outrun.
