Footnotes

EMBRACEABLE WIN stalked the pace three wide, ranged up four wide outside rivals approaching the quarter pole, took command in upper stretch, forged clear under right handed pressure a furlong out then steadily widened while kept alert. MONSTER SLEEPING saved ground, got through lodging a bid mid turn, took a short lead soon after, dueled into the lane, gave way grudgingly and saved the place. CYPRESS ISLE settled off the pace, made progress towards the rail in mid stretch, altered out near the sixteenth marker, had her rider drop his whip once inside the sixteenth pole and kept on with interest. BLUE GERANIUM settled back off the pace, came under a bit of hand urging past the five sixteenths marker, was gathered back up under a rating hold in upper stretch, shifted out inside the sixteenth pole, closed belatedly then was keen on to go on through the gallop out. E Z PASSER held a short early advantage, was overtaken from the outside after a quarter mile, re-bid three wide between runners mid turn to poke a head in front, checked when attempting to get out approaching the stretch, regrouped inside the three sixteenths pole and kept on willingly. JIM THE DANCER pulled outside to command near the five eighths pole, spurted clear and angled to the two path soon after, was joined leaving the three eighths pole, dueled between runners nearing the lane then faded in the final furlong. FOURSOUTHERNBELLES, wide, was not a factor. An objection by the rider of E Z PASSER against the winner for alleged interference entering the lane was not allowed
