OH SAY VICKI prompted the pace two wide in hand, gained a short lead nearing the quarter pole, went clear and steadily widened under a drive. ISLANDER BLUES raced four wide early, advanced three wide in hand on the turn, chased the winner home and finished willingly. MONZY set a pressured pace along the inside, was roused nearing the quarter pole, swerved out late and held the show. LOVING PRINCESS chased the pace along the inside, eased out some in the lane and came up empty. TWYLA raced between rivals early, entered the lane four wide and failed to mount a serious rally. RUNAWAY FROZE angled to the rail soon after the start, settled into the turn, swung very wide for the drive and finished with interest. HYATT ROAD chased the pace off the rail and weakened. FLYING CHARLOTTE bobbled a bit leaving the gate and passed a tired rival. CLEVER ACCOUNT raced close up behind rivals into the turn and tired before going a half mile.
