Footnotes

HITCHIN' TOTHEMOON set a rated pace two wide, increased his lead into the lane, responded to solid right handed pressure through the final three sixteenths and held SAMURAI SWORD safe. SAMURAI SWORD, taken to rate early while four wide, advanced under a ride leaving the far turn, had aim on the winner entering the stretch, continued willingly but was denied. BRAND NEW MOVES, three wide between rivals stalking the pace, made a mild bid under strong urging into the lane, failed to sustain and gave way in the final three sixteenths. ASTRONOMICAL, unhurried early, circled the turn four wide but failed to make an impact. DE BANDELERO saved ground into the turn, was ridden along mid turn, angled out three wide for the drive but failed to be a factor. DERWIN'S PRINCE, forced in at the break, was straightened away and hustled up along the rail, chased the pace into the turn, dropped back mid turn and altered out wide in upper stretch. SACK EM TROY prompted the early pace inside the winner and tired. CALL TO ORDER came in at the break, chased the early pace off the rail and faltered around the turn.
