Footnotes

TUSCANY'S PROSPECT chased the pace, raced in the three path leaving the turn, swept to command approaching the eighth pole then drew out under steady handling. FATHER MUDD raced along the rail on the turn, eased out in upper stretch, swung very wide in midstretch, lugged in near the sixteenth pole and rallied. RAISE A READER bore in leaving the starting gate, hugged the rail, disputed the pace to midstretch then faded. SATURDAY AT TEN bore in leaving the starting gate, was in tight quarters inside RAISE A READER soon after the break, raced in the two path between horses on the turn, eased out for the drive and had a slight rally. RIDGE AMOUR raced well off the rail and passed tired horses. ALL FOR PEACE lacked speed, raced wide on the turn and was outrun. DROP IT NOW , unhurried early, swung wide in midstretch and offered a mild, late rally. SAINTLY LOVE , inside horses in the stretch, was not a factor. BANKERS SOLO , steadied when pinched back leaving the starting gate, was outrun and raced very wide on the turn. HROSSEY FERRY disputed the pace two wide and faltered in upper stretch. BREEZY LOUIE saved ground on the turn, swung out in upper stretch then faltered. An objection by the rider of SATURDAY AT TEN against RAISE A READER for alleged interference leaving the starting gate was not allowed.
