Footnotes

CHEROKEE ARTIST easily cleared under rating mid way on the first turn, dictated the pace three wide, moved off to a solid lead after a half mile then held firm under solid handling the final furlong. BAILEYS BEACH, taken to rate early, steadily advanced four wide past the five furlong marker, chased the winner from the five sixteenths pole and held well to be clearly best of the rest. ZARROC saved ground under rating, got through along the rail entering the stretch but lacked a solid response. SKY MAGGY, content to rate back off the winner, came under a ride two wide mid way on the final turn, failed to respond and faded. TIZ RELEVANT settled back off the pace, came five wide for the drive and no kick. NINTH CLIENT was rated back off the lead, raced between rivals early, dropped back around the final turn then steadied when in close in upper stretch. NO BRAKES broke a step slow and was outrun.
